### **2017 City of Emmett Spring Cleanup Events**

#### Disposal Guidelines for Team Cleanup Day: Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>

- The Mayor's Team Cleanup Day and Contest is scheduled for Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017. To ensure pick up, have your special yard waste out by 7:00 a.m. next to your trash on your regular trash collection day the week of June 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Grass clippings, leafs, bundled branches and special yard waste items must be placed at the curb for collection. The sanitation crews will not enter your property.
- As always, please bag your yard waste before placing it in your garbage can or cart.
- Tree limbs and branches that will not fit in your cans or cart should be cut into four-foot lengths, bundled no larger than three feet in diameter, and tied with rope or twine.
- For the safety of the route workers, please do not overload trash cans or bags with more than 40 pounds of material each.
- This applies to yard clean up waste only. Limited quantities of special, large or bulky items such as furniture, appliances, mattresses, etc., can be dropped off free-of-charge at City Park May 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> (restrictions apply). Otherwise, you may contact Emmett Sanitation in advance for an estimate on special collection fees for your particular circumstances.

## Disposal Guidelines for Large & Bulky Item Drop-off: Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>

- Please bring a current household City utility bill as proof of residency.
- There are limitations on this event. Limit of two (2) items per household. Space is limited and the event will end once the containers are full.
- The event is intended primarily for large or bulky household items. There are special restrictions on this City event.\* Acceptable items include:

**Furniture** including chairs, recliners, couches, tables, mattresses, carpet, rugs, etc.

**Limited electronics** like computers, monitors and old televisions

Small appliances like lamps, old fans, vacuums, microwaves, televisions

\*Restricted items that carry an extra charge include all types of tires, car/truck wheels, as well as general large appliances like stoves, water heaters, washers, dryers, microwaves, or air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, and other appliances containing Asbestos or Freon. These items can be properly disposed of with a special fee. Please contact Emmett Sanitation at (208) 365-6103 in advance for an estimate on charges (typical charge is between \$2-12 per item) and to approve/arrange payment ahead of time and for special item disposal instructions.

Helpful tips before you arrive on Saturday:

- 1. Please have your bulky items organized and prepared ahead of time
- 2. Limited assistance is available for the elderly or disabled at the drop-site. Please plan to safely unload your item(s) from your own vehicle.

## The following material is NOT ACCEPTED as part of the 2017 City Park or Team Cleanup Day event(s):

- Tires or wheels
- Truck or auto bodies
- Dirt, sod, brick, concrete or rock
- Debris from construction, remodeling or demolition projects
- · Commercial or Business Waste
- · Liquid or bodily waste
- Dead animals (please contact your local Humane Society for assistance)
- Ashes or other flammable materials such as solvents, oil, propane, gas or diesel
- Batteries, paint or hazardous materials that have a label including:

# "Poison, Toxic, Corrosive, Volatile, Flammable, Inflammable, Combustible, Explosive, Danger, Caution, Warning, Harmful"
