Emmett City Code Title 9, Chapter 12, and Title 8, Chapter 7, governs all Signs within the City. Signs permanent and temporary greater than four square feet that are not exempt under Section 9-12-7 of City Code, must have a sign permit to be erected, altered, or relocated. The supporting structure must meet the requirements of the current version of the International Building Code (I.B.C.) as adopted by the State of Idaho and all other applicable codes of the City of Emmett. The State of Idaho Division of Building Safety Electrical Bureau governs electrical work and a separate State Electrical Permit will be required for electrical signs. The following items must be included with this application in order for it to be reviewed (City Code 9-12-4-2): A site plan drawn to scale that specifies the building frontage, the location of the sign structure(s), and drawings which show the scale of the sign in context with the scale of the building if the sign is to be mounted on the building. Colored rendering including dimensions of all sign faces, descriptions of materials to be used, manner of construction and method of attachment, and, if requested, color samples. Detail of foundation height, width, depth and reinforcement placement for monument and pole signs. Specify type, location, and number of connections. Pole signs shall specify the connection for the cabinet, the cabinet to the top of the pole, and the pole to the foundation. Monument signs shall specify the connection to the foundation. Walls signs shall specify the connection of the sign to the building. A copy of a State of Idaho Electrical Installation Permit for any internally lighted or neon sign. The building permit fee for signs as approved by resolution of the Emmett City Council.
